How does this year deliver your curriculum intent?

Students will continue to explore music of varying styles in order to develop their own creativity, experience cultures different to their own and support a deeper awareness of historical time periods and its impact on music at the time. Students will be inspired to work in and/or be enriched by an ever-changing industry, influenced by technological developments by experimenting with music technology such as band lab and garage band. They will develop a wider knowledge to musical contexts such as composing for a brief. They will develop practical, interpersonal and thinking skills, whilst working within a group/team. They will be encouraged to offer challenge to themselves and others. They will work to deadlines, work independently, research and apply their knowledge through song writing and notation.
